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

"Revitalizing Legal Education in Pakistan:

Challenges and Opportunities"

Legal education plays a critical role in the development of a just and equitable society. In Pakistan, the quality of legal education has been a subject of much debate and criticism. While some argue that legal education in Pakistan is adequate, others believe that there are significant shortcomings in the system that need to be addressed.



#### New wave of Terrorism in Pakistan

Pakistan has seen a recent up stick in terrorism particularly after the Tehreek-Taliban Pakistan (TTP) broke its ceasefire and ordered its fighters to resume attacks across the country. Since the Afghan Taliban took the charge of Afghanistan in August 2021, terrorist's attacks have been increased by 55% in Pakistan. The vulnerability of Pakistan's counterterrorism victories has been brought into stark relief by the resurgence of terrorism. The primary cause of the resurgence of terrorism in Pakistan is the country's shortsighted Afghan policy of backing the Taliban, which allowed the organization to retake power. Pakistan supported the Taliban in opposition to the Kabul regimes that were backed by the United States in an effort to encircle India and use it to control the TTP. It was revitalized by the Afghan Taliban's rise to power. The group hailed the victory of the Taliban as its own. There have been long-standing ideological, political, and ethnic ties between the TTP and the Taliban. As a result, the Afghan Taliban regime claimed that the TTP was an internal matter for Pakistan rather than providing any assistance. In exchange for Pakistan and the TTP agreeing to settle their differences, the Taliban only offered to assist in facilitating talks to reach a political settlement. Another factor contributing to the rise of terrorism is Pakistan's weakness in entering into negotiations with the TTP which gave the group much needed-time to expand its network in Pakistan. The first attempt at a peace agreement was made in 2021, but it failed when the TTP ended the one-month truce in December and started attacking again. Another attempt was made in May 2022. It resulted in a formal peace agreement between the two sides and an ongoing ceasefire in June. The ex-FATA (Federally Administered Tribal Areas) region's merger with Khyber Pakhtunkhwa was one issue on which both sides refused to budge, and as a result, peace negotiations quickly came to an end. Pakistan refused to agree to the TTP's demand that the merger be reversed. Pakistan's greatest challenge is to maintain peace and preventing a new reign of terror across the country inspired by the TTP in these time of numerous crisis. A strategy for dealing with various militant threats will require even more long-term planning. Pakistan must reevaluate its approach to dealing with the Taliban government in Afghanistan if it wants to secure its western border. While dialogue with the Taliban government is important, Islamabad must also be clear about its position on terrorist attacks coming from Afghanistan.



# Law Domain Specific Vocabulary and Expression



#### Women in law

Almost 3005 Pakistani judges working in the lower and higher court, only 519 or 17% are women and also only 102 females lawyer are registered as supreme court lawyers. In 2022, 38.3% of lawyers were female while 61.5% were male. The legislation assembly of Pakistan has enacted a number of measures designed to give women more power in the areas of family, inheritance, revenue, civil and criminal law but in the field of law, women's are facing gender discrimination till now. They say justice must not only be done but also must be seen to be done but now more than ever, many say it would be good to see it done by a women There are only 5 women (two each in the high courts of Sindh and Lahore and one in Peshawar). For nearly 65 years since Pakistan supreme court was established, justice was melted out at the highest courts by men only and on one really noticed. But mow first female supreme court justice (Justice Ayesha Malik) has been appointed to this office. However, there are many question arised after the appointments of Justice Malik that this is the first step in enhancing women's participation and standing in the legal profession in Pakistan?. No matter how laudable, to magically erase the very considerable institutional, social, and cultural obstacles faced daily by women lawyers throughout the country.

There are scores of women judges in session and districts courts, they are rarely elevated to the high courts. Many suffer in silence facing aggression, misogyny and sexism from lawyers. The same toxic culture is faced daily by female lawyers at the workplace\_ in the court and firms. They start their legal career with the dream legal dispute work but end up pick out for chambers work, said Karachi young lawyers. The situation therefor can only be change if women lawyers themselves take the lead and co-opt their more truly enlightened male colleagues in their cause. Because "out of 198 members only six are women across the bar council," Women in law founder Nida Usman chaudary told Dawn that male lawyers don't want reserved seats for women."but we do want a limit on the majority of a gender. No one more than two-thirds of one gender should compose any council," she said. These efforts must generate enough serious women lawyers that instead of waiting for an Asma Jahangir, Ashraf Jahan or Ayesha Malik to emerge every few decades, there exists a critical mass of women lawyers who can come forward and claim not only judicial appointments but also other positions of power within the profession as their right rather than as exceptions made or prizes grant on them by the amplitude of their male counterparts. US President Jimmy Carter appointed 41 female judges. He said he "was determined to see that women and minorities, whose destinies have so often depended upon the kind of justice that our courts can provide, should be included in those judgeships." Why do we lack this determination when appointing women to the bench?



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




#### ART AND CREATIVITY




